

Lycopene's antioxidative powers on show at HI Japan

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Additionally, visitors will be able to reduce their own stress levels by getting a massage at Lycored's booth (1-103). Mr Shimoto will give a presentation to the event on October 4th (13:00-13:50 at Seminar Place B). He will say that in addition to being an effective antioxidant, lycopene stimulates the body's own cellular defence mechanism against oxidative stress. Reduced levels of lycopene in the blood are associated with impaired vascular function and cardiovascular conditions such as hypertension. Lycopene also supports the health and appearance of the skin by reducing photodamage, and is effective in

protecting against eye diseases.

Lycomato, Lycored's standardized tomato extract is processed from selected ripe, non-GMO tomatoes that provide lycopene and other phytonutrients with antioxidant capacity. Supplementation increases levels of carotenoids in plasma, skin and adipose tissue.

Last year, Lycored created the Lycopedia, an interactive educational hub that tells the story of Lycopene and its effect on the body at different stages of life.
